### Regular checks

The following checks should be carried out by the user to ensure that the system remains in good working order:

**Daily:** check the Indicator Station. The screen should display the message: ‘Alarms Normal’, and the green LED will pulse regularly.

**Weekly:** At least one Howler alarm point should be tested each week, on a rotating cycle, so that all alarm points are tested from time to time.

**Six monthly:** All the Howler alarms should be tested. Automatic detection should be visually inspected and cleaned if necessary.

**Annually:** In addition to the six-monthly test, all detectors should be tested using specialist aerosols or heat-guns designed for testing smoke and heat detectors. This test equipment is available from Howler UK.

All checks as well as faults and disconnects should be noted in the log-book provided to show evidence of regular checks. **This is a condition of the warranty.**
